

## Children on Premises Policy

The Two Birds' Nest is proudly a community space which welcomes patrons of all ages.

However, to ensure the safety and comfort of everyone in the brewery, the following requirements must be observed in accordance with the Victorian Commission for Gambling and Liquor Regulation and the Two Birds Children on Premises Policy.

Please ensure:

- Children aged 18 years and under must be supervised by a parent or responsible adult *at all times*
- **Supervision requires that children must remain seated and in the company of a responsible adult while inside the premises. Running is not permitted**
- Bar staff cannot take responsibility for the supervision of children within the premises at any time
- Common sense should be used at all times. Parents are responsible for setting boundaries for their child's behaviour in consideration of the comfort, enjoyment and safety of all patrons
- It is the responsibility of the parent/responsible adult to ensure the welfare of their children
- Children must be accompanied by a parent/responsible adult to use the toilet facilities

Please note that Two Birds strive to provide all patrons with an enjoyable and safe experience meaning disruptive behaviour will not be tolerated. Children who are left unsupervised and are found to be running on premises and/or behaving in a manner which compromises the Two Birds Children on Premises Policy will be asked to leave the premises.
